

BYLAW # 1/78


A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF KELVINGTON #366, PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN, TO SET UP A RECREATION BOARD.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Kelvington #366, Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The council of the municipality shall create a recreation board which shall be known as the recreation board of the Rural Municipality of Kelvington #366.
2. The function of the recreation board shall be to work in conjunction with the recreation boards serving R.M. of Kelvington #366 to administer, promote and co-ordinate recreation activities of the communities served by the said recreation boards.
3. The said boards shall be represented by a member appointed by council and shall hold office until such time as a successor is appointed.
4. The Board shall on or before the 1st. day of March in each year prepare and submit in writing to the council detailed reports of their previous year's activities plus their projection of the coming year's activities and their budgets.
5. There shall be a free flow of communication between the recreation boards and the Council of the municipality as to the requirements, activities and progress of recreation programs within the respective communities.
6. Provincial funding available shall be applied for and when received shall be disbursed to the participating recreation boards in accordance with Council's approved allocation for the year under review.

Read three times by unanimous vote and passed by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Kelvington #366 at Kelvington in the Province of Saskatchewan this 9th. day of June, A.D. 1978.
