

A Bylaw to provide for entering into an agreement respecting  
The Provision of Fire Protection Services.

The Council of The Rural Municipality of Kelvington #366,  
Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Rural Municipality of Kelvington #366 is hereby authorized  
to enter into the agreement, attached hereto and forming part of this  
bylaw, and identified as Exhibit A, with the following municipalities:

The Town of Kelvington

The Rural Municipality of Sasman #336

for the purposes stated within the agreement.

2. The Reeve and secretary-treasurer  
of the Rural Municipality of Kelvington #366 are hereby authorized  
to sign and execute the attached agreement identified as Exhibit A.

AGREEMENT FOR PROVIDING FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made this 11th day of May

1979 A.D.

BETWEEN:

The Town of Kelvington hereinafter referred to as the Town  
The Rural Municipality of Sasman #336  
The Rural Municipality of Kelvington #366

THIS AGREEMENT WITNESETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. The parties to this agreement agree to jointly provide fire protection services to the residents of the municipalities party to this agreement as follows:

- a. To the whole of the Town of Kelvington
- b. To that portion of the Rural Municipality of Sasman #336 within the following townships or portions of townships:
  - Township 36 Range 10 West of
  - Township 36 Range 11
  - Township 36 Range 12 except sections 4 to 9
  - Township 35 Range 11 except sections 1 to 12
  - Township 35 Range 10 except sections 1 to 12
- c. To the whole of the Rural Municipality of Kelvington #366

2. The parties to this agreement further agree that

- a. Equipment will be provided as follows: The Town will provide a 1978 fire truck unit to be housed in the Town's fire hall and a 1946 fire truck unit to be housed in the Town's machinery storage shed located across the street from the fire hall, and, The Kelvington Rural Fire Association will provide a 1964 fire truck unit for use by agreement with the municipalities participating in this agreement within the areas set out in paragraph 1. of this agreement, this truck to be housed in the Town's fire hall.

Note: It is agreed between The Kelvington Rural Fire Association and The Town of Kelvington that for fires occurring within the Town the 1978 truck unit will be used but for larger fires The Kelvington Rural Fire Association's unit will also be used and that the reverse will be in effect for rural fires, with the Town's second unit available in either case if required.

- b. The fire trucks will be manned by a volunteer fire brigade of both Town and rural residents with the majority being from the Town and they shall be under the direction of a fire chief or a deputy fire chief both of whom shall be appointed by the Town.
- c. The Town agrees to pay for the operation and maintenance of the fire hall and their own fire trucks and equipment and required payments to the fire chief and other members of the fire brigade.

Note: The Kelvington Rural Fire Association in their agreement with the Town agrees to pay for repairs, maintenance and operating costs of their own fire truck unit, \$200. a month rent to the Town to help defray the costs of light, heat, telephone, insurance, etc. of the fire hall and to pay the wages, grants and other costs to the firemen when called to rural fires.

- d. The Rural Municipalities agree to provide a grant to The Kelvington Rural Fire Association, as set out in separate agreements between the Rural Municipalities and The Kelvington Rural Fire Association, their approximate share of the budgetary requirements of the said Association as requested each year with the amount being subject to the approval of the councils of the rural municipalities, and, The Kelvington Rural Fire Association agrees to provide fire protection service to the areas of the rural municipalities described in Paragraph 1. of this agreement.

3. This agreement replaces a verbal agreement which was in effect to Dec. 31, 1978.
4. This agreement shall be in effect January 1, 1979.

5. It is understood and agreed that this agreement shall be continuous but the agreement may be terminated by either party to the agreement giving thirty days notice in writing prior to January 1st. in any year.
