



A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 22/98 KNOWN AS THE ZONING BYLAW


The Council of the Rural Municipality of Kelvington No. 366, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw No. 22/98 as follows:

1. Section 2.7 Fees and Advertising, subsection (1) *Amendment of the Zoning Bylaw*, is amended by deleting the current text and substituting the following therefor: "Where a person requests council to amend the zoning bylaw that person shall pay to the municipality:
  - (a) an amendment request fee equal to \$200.00, such sum to accompany the request; and
  - (b) a fee equal to the costs associated with the public advertisement of the proposed amendment.
2. The Zoning District Map (Insert 1) referred to in Section 4 is amended by rezoning from C-Commercial District to RR-Resort Residential District all the land shown within the bold line on the attached sketch, which forms part of the bylaw.
3. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final approval by the Minister of Municipal Affairs, Culture and Housing.






