

BYLAW NO. 38/05

A BYLAW TO AMEND BYLAW NO. 23/98 BEING A BYLAW CONCERNING THE ERECTION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SIGNS RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT, 1989

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Kelvington No. 366, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Bylaw No. 23/98 is amended as follows:


(1) Section 2 concerning the erection of "stop" signs shall be amended by replacing item 6. and by inserting new items 14. and 15. to read as shown below.

6. SE 4-38-12-W2	West	North	North
14. SE 18-39-11-W2	West	North	North
15. NW 8-39-11-W2	East	South	South

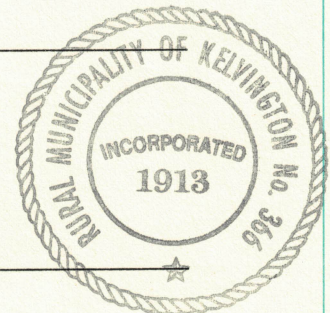

(2) Section 3 concerning the erection of "yield" signs shall be amended by replacing items 12. and 25. to read as shown below and by deleting the contents of item 27.

25. SW 14-38-11-W2	West	North	North


