

BYLAW NO. 46/06

A BYLAW TO LICENSE THE DRILLING OF
OIL AND GAS WELLS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Kelvington No. 366, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


1. For the purpose of this bylaw:

"Contractor" shall include any person, firm or corporation; and
"Municipality" shall mean the Rural Municipality of Kelvington No. 366.


2. Any contractor undertaking well-drilling in the municipality shall pay to the municipality the following license fee:

(a) for the drilling of an oil well or a gas well - \$ 450.00

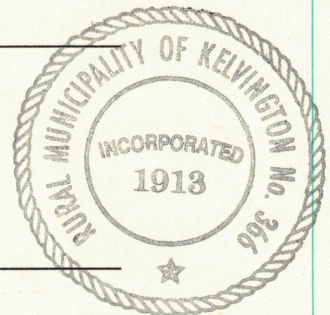
(b) for the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information - \$ 225.00




