

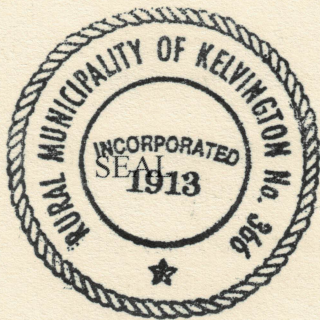
RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF KELVINGTON NO. 366

BYLAW NO. 87-2022

A Bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 22/98 known as the Zoning Bylaw under subsection 46(3) of *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*.

The Council of the RM of Kelvington No. 366, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts to amend Bylaw 22/98 as follows:

1. **Subsection 5.3.4, Number of Residences on a Parcel, in the A-Agricultural District is amended by adding the following directly after 5.3.4 (a):**
 - (b) Notwithstanding clause 5.3.4(a)(i), Council may use its discretion to vary the minimum site size requirement of 80 acres for two residences where:
 - (i) the change is requested to accommodate existing residences and to respond to existing landscaping or other physical circumstances unique to the site; and
 - (ii) the reduced site size will not diminish the ability of the land to be used for agricultural purposes.
2. **This bylaw shall come into force and take effect when it has been approved by the Minister of Government Relations.**
