

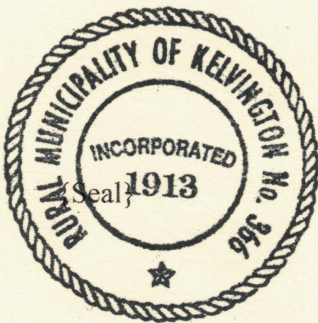
RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF KELVINGTON NO. 366

BYLAW NO. 90 – 2022

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING OF
OPERATORS OF TRAILER PARKS OR CAMPS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Kelvington No. 366, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. No person shall operate a trailer park or court within the boundaries of the municipality without first obtaining a licence from the administrator.
2. The licence fee shall be a one-time advance payment of Twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and shall expire on the date the operator ceases operations or transfers ownership of the park.
3. The operator of a trailer park or camp licenced under this bylaw is hereby authorized and required to collect from the occupant of any trailer, mobile home or portable shack situated within the confines of the park or camp such licence fee as is required to be paid by such occupant under Bylaw No. 89-2022 of the municipality.
4. All fees collected under Section 3 of this bylaw shall be turned over to the administrator of the municipality prior to October 1 of each year.
5. It shall be the responsibility of the operator of a trailer park or camp licenced under this bylaw to register each trailer or portable shack located therein in a proper record maintained for that purpose showing the name of the occupant, date of arrival and the date of departure. Any fees collected under Section 4 of this bylaw shall also be recorded opposite the name of the registered occupant, together with the date of collection.
6. The record mentioned in Section 5 shall be open to inspection at all times to the licence inspector of the municipality.
7. Sections 4 to 8 of this bylaw shall apply mutatis mutandis to every owner or occupant of property who permits two or more trailers or portable shacks to be located thereon.
8. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
9. Bylaw No. 50/07 is hereby repealed.
10. This bylaw shall come into effect on the day of its final passing.
