

Furley the Froggy

Crochet Pattern

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Skill Level: *Intermediate Beginner*

Materials:

- *Yarn: Any medium/worsted weight yarn of your choice
I used: Red Heart Super Saver (Spring green, White, Black, Baby Pink & Hunter Green)*
- *2.75 hook (C)*
- *Stitch marker*
- *Stuffing*
- *Tapestry needle*

Finished size: approximately 6" tall including eyes

The size depends on what type of yarn and hook you use.

Abbreviations:

- **MR:** magic ring
- **ch:** chain
- **st:** stitch
- **sl st:** slip stitch
- **CC:** change color
- **sc:** single crochet
- **inc:** increase
- **dec:** decrease
- **FO:** fasten off
- *** repeat***

Notes:

Pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Use a stitch marker to keep track. Furley is worked from feet up. Attaching arms at the end.

Let's Begin!

Legs: make 2 (FO the first leg but not the second)

Start with **Spring Green**

Rnd 1: 4sc into MR (4)

Rnd 2: *inc* (4x) (8)

Rnd 3: BLO, sc around (8)

Rnd 4: sc in the next 3sts, dec, sc in the next 3sts (7)

Rnds 5-11: sc around (7) Start stuffing (*use chopstick to push stuffing in*)

Leave a long tail to close up the hole between the legs.

FO, repeat for the second leg but do not FO.

Rnd 12: sc in the next 3sts, then sc on to the other leg. (make sure both legs are facing the same direction) continue to sc in the next 7sts and then 4sts on the leg you started with (14)

Body:

Rnd 13: sc around (14)



Sc in the next 3 st

Sc on the next sc of the other leg
to join

Rnd 14: inc, sc in the next 6sts, inc, sc in the next 6sts (16)

Rnds 15-16: sc around (16)

Rnd 17: dec, sc in the next 6sts, dec, sc in the next 6sts (14)

Rnd 18: dec, sc in the next 5sts, dec, sc in the next 5sts (12)

Rnd 19: dec, sc in the next 4sts, dec, sc in the next 4sts (10)

Rnd 20: dec, sc in the next 3sts, dec, sc in the next 3sts (8)

Continue to the Head:

Rnd 21: sc around (8)

Rnd 22: *inc* (8x) (16)

Rnd 23: *sc, inc* (8x) (24)

Rnd 24: *sc in the next 2sts, inc* (8x) (32)

Rnds 25-28: sc around (32)

Rnd 29: *sc in the next 2sts, dec* (8x) (24)

Rnd 30: sc around (24)

Rnd 31: *sc in the next 2sts, dec* (6x) (18)

Rnd 32: *sc, dec* (6x) (12) *Finish stuffing.*

Rnd 33: *dec* (6x) (6)

FO, leaving a tail to sew the hole closed.

Arms: (make 2) *Spring Green*

Rnd 1: 5sc into MR (5)

Rnds 2-10: sc around (5)

FO, leaving a tail to sew arms onto body.

Eyes: (make 2) Start with Black

Rnd 1: 6sc in MR, sl st (6), CC to White

Rnd 2: *inc* (6x) (12), CC to Green

Rnds 3-4: sc around (12)

Rnd 5: *sc, dec* (4x) (8)

Rnd 6: *dec* (4x) (4)

FO, leaving tail for sewing the hole closed and for sewing onto top of the head.



Do not stuff, flatten the back with your hands.



Blush: (make 2) *Baby Pink*

In MR, sc (6x)

FO, leaving a tail for sewing on the sides of his face.



Scarf: *Hunter Green*

Ch36, on the 2nd st from the hook *sc, ch1, skip 1, sc on the next st*

FO, and weave tails.

- Wrap the scarf around his neck and embroider a big smile on Furley.
