Crochet Sunflower for Ukraine

Crochet Pattern

This pattern design may <mark>no</mark>t be distrib<mark>uted</mark> or sold <mark>as yo</mark>ur own, but feel free to sell a finished item and to share pattern freely.

Skill Level: Intermediate

Materials:

- Yarn: Any aran cotton weight yarn of your choice, Blue, Yellow, Brown, & Green
- I used: Paintbox Yarn Cotton Aran- Marine Blue, Mustard Yellow, Coffee Bean, & Grass Green
 - 3.50 hook (E)
 - Stitch marker
 - Stuffing
 - Poly pellets (optional)
 - Pipe cleaner (optional)
 - Tapestry needle

Finished size: approximately 5" tall. Size depends on what type of yarn and hook you use.

Abbreviations:

- MR: magic ring
- **ch**: chain
- **st**: stitch
- sl st: slip stitch
- CC: change color
- sc: single crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- dc: double crochet
- inc: increase
- dec: decrease
- BLO: back loop only
- FLO: front loop only
- FO: fasten off
- * repeat*

Let's begin!

Dirt: Brown

Rnd 1: 6sc in MR, sl st to join (6)

Rnd 2: ch1, *inc* (6x), sl st (12)

Rnd 3: ch1, *sc, inc* (6x), sl st (18)

Rnd 4: ch1, *sc in the next 2sts, inc* (6x), sl st (24)

Rnd 5: ch1, *sc in the next 3sts, inc* (6x), sl st (30)

FO, weave in tail.

Pot: Starting with Yellow

Rnd 1: 6sc in MR, sl st to join (6)

Rnd 2: ch1, *inc* (6x), sl st (12)

Rnd 3: ch1, *sc, inc* (6x), sl st (18)

Rnd 4: ch1, *sc in the next 2sts, inc* (6x), sl st (24)

Rnd 5: BLO, ch1, *sc in the next 3sts, inc* (6x), sl st (30)

Rnds 6-8: sc around, sl st (30), CC to Blue

Rnds 9-12: sc around, sl st (30)



Rnd 13: Place the dirt inside the pot and line it up with Rnd 12. Stuff with stuffing or poly pellets. Do not over stuff. Working in both loops of both pieces, sc around the pot. (24) (see photo 2)

Rnd 14: *ch1, sl st* (30x) (30)

FO, weave in tails.

With the bottom of the pot facing towards you, join with a sl st in FLO of Rnd 4, with Yellow, sl st around (24) (see photo 3)







Stem: Starting with Brown

Rnd 1: 6sc in MR, sl st to join (6)

Rnd 2: ch1, *inc* (6x), sl st (12), Stuff.

FO, weave in tail.

In the **BLO**, of **Rnd 2**, With Green sl st to join (see photo 5)

Rnd 3: sc around (12) You can continue to stuff as you go or add pipe cleaner by folding it in half and inserting it into the stem.

Rnd 4: *dec* (6x) (6)

Rnds 5-9: sc around **(6)**

FO, leaving a tail for sewing.




Petals: Yellow

In the **FLO** of **Rnd 2**, with **Yellow**, sl st to join (see photo 6) *ch7, starting in the 2nd ch from the hook, sl st, sc, hdc in the next 4chs, sl st in the same space, sl st in the next st (12x) **(12 petals)** *FO, weave in tails. (see photo 7)*







Leaf: Green

ch5, starting from the 2^{nd} ch of the hook, sl st, hdc, dc, dc, sl st in the same st


FO, leaving a tail for sewing.

Assembly:

- Sew stem to the soil
- Sew leaf on the stem
- Straighten the petals
