An unforgettable cultural experience awaits you!

Afternoon: Guided tour of the Royal Palace. It is one of the most beautiful and well preserved in Europe and, like all the Royal Sites managed by the National Heritage, it is regularly used by their Majesties the King and Queen of Spain for official events. It is one of the few official residences of Heads of State that is open to the public, which makes the Palace come alive. After leaving the Palace, you can enjoy both the beautiful Sabatini Gardens and the Campo del Moro Gardens: two hidden and very special corners of Madrid.

Dinner: On your own.

## DAY 06 TOLEDO

Breakfast: Buffet at the hotel.

Morning: Departure to Toledo (1.hr), the medieval capital of Spain until 1560. Toledo was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1966. Guided tour of a city with outstanding Jewish, Muslim and Christian quarters, highlighting the peaceful coexistence of these three communities. There is a fascinating entrance to the city under the Puerta de la Bisagra; its most recognisable gate which has the coat of arms of the Imperial City at the top.

As you enter Toledo, you will be impressed by the Gothic style of the Primate Cathedral, the paintings in the El Greco House Museum and the imposing Alcázar of Toledo, from where you can take in beautiful views of the Tagus River and the surrounding mountains.

Lunch: : On your own.

Afternoon: Free time to wander around the narrow cobbled streets of the old city while enjoying performances by various street artists in different corners. Return to Madrid by coach.

Dinner: On your own.

#### DAY 07 MADRID

Breakfast: Buffet at the hotel.

Morning: We leave for the pickleball courts at 09:00 and play from 09:30 to 12:00, showers and lockers available at the courts.
