GENERAL PRICE LIST

Prices effective October 3, 2024 and subject to change without notice.

Since the 1920's the first and second generations were already building caskets in Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico. In the mid 1960's the third and fourth generations established funeral homes in the same city. In the late 1990's, the fifth generation began working in the funeral industry in the city of San José, California.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Prior to the drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party, or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements, is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

California Health and Safety Code Section 102800 require physicians to sign the medical portion of the death certificate within 15 hours of death, or by the coroner within three days, after examination of the body. We will not be responsible for delays in services or disposition where a physician has failed to discharge his or her final duty to the patient and their family.

Our policy for services and merchandise selected are required to be paid in full 48 hours prior to any scheduled service and prior to final disposition of the deceased. We accept Money Orders, Cashiers Checks, Visa, and Master Card. Cash payments will include a discount. **We are sorry, but we do not accept personal checks.**

Primary Services

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

Our services include: readiness to serve 24 hours; conducting the arrangements conference; planning funeral services; shelter of remains; obtaining necessary governmental forms and authorizations for final disposition; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, clergy, common carriers, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses to serve the public.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

We offer discounted rates for families not opting for services outside of regular hours. This discount applies to a traditional package for client-families who do not select viewing or visitation services after 4:00 PM on weekdays or on Saturday mornings (limited to 15 minutes to a maximum of 3 hours).

Air Cargo Rates (Domestic and International)
Cargo is categorized as Cash Advances. Rates apply to uncremated Human Remains, service may not be available for all cities. Applicable to shipments weighing approximately 350 pounds, including container, (for some airlines the limited weight is 350 pounds). Shipments weighing more than 350 pounds, including container, incurs additional charges.

Most airline rates for Infant Human Remains weighing less than 75 lbs, including container.

Minimum Packages

Direct Cremation Price Range:

Our charge for a direct cremation (**without embalming, container or casket, viewing, death certificate, permit, or ceremony**) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; local van transportation of deceased from place of death; care and custody of deceased; unscheduled local van transportation to crematory and crematory fee. Cremation cannot take place until a death certificate is filed and a permit issued by the local county.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide are made of fiberboard, composition material, or wood.

Direct cremation with container/casket selected from our inventory

Our charge for an immediate burial (**without embalming, casket, viewing, flowers, ceremony, death certificate, permit, or cemetery property**) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; local van transportation of deceased from place of death; care and custody of deceased; unscheduled local van transportation to cemetery. Burial cannot take place until a death certificate is filed and a permit issued by the county.

Immediate burial
(in addition to the cost of the casket; it could also be provided by the purchaser)

Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Home

Our charge (**without other preparation, casket, viewing, ceremony, air tray, common carrier charges, or if applicable, consulate fees and documents required by consulate or receiving funeral home**) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; local van transportation of deceased from place of death; care and custody of deceased; embalming; and unscheduled local van transportation to common carrier. Forwarding cannot take place until a death certificate filed and a permit issued by the county.

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home

Our charge (**without other preparation, casket, viewing, ceremony, common carrier, cemetery, or crematory charges & DCA Fees**) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; local van transportation of deceased from common carrier; care and custody of deceased; burial or cremation permit; and unscheduled local van transportation to cemetery or crematory.
