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GENERAL PRICE LIST

Prices effective July 1, 2026 and subject to change without notice.

Since the 1920s, the first and second generations of our family built caskets in Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico. In the mid-1960s, the third and fourth generations established funeral homes in the same city. In the late 1990s, the fifth generation began working in the funeral industry in San José, California.

Prior to drafting any contract for goods or services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

California Health and Safety Code section 102800 requires the medical and health section of the death certificate and the certifier's certification to be completed by the attending physician or nurse practitioner within 15 hours after death, or by the coroner within three days after examination of the body. Funeral services and final disposition may be delayed when certification, registration, or permit issuance is not completed within the required timeframe or is otherwise delayed by the certifier or governmental agency.

Payment in full for all selected services and merchandise is required at least 48 hours before any scheduled service and before final disposition of the deceased. We accept cash, Visa, Mastercard, and PayPal. Cash prices reflect a discount.

We do not accept personal checks.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Primary Services

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff

Our services include: readiness to serve 24 hours; conducting the arrangements conference; planning funeral services; shelter of remains; obtaining necessary governmental forms and authorizations for final disposition; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, clergy, common carriers, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of taxes, licenses, utilities and business expenses to serve the public.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

Embalming

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

Shipments weighing more than 350 pounds, including container, incurs additional charges.

Direct Cremation Price Range Below:

Our charge for a direct cremation (without embalming, container or casket, viewing, death certificate, permit, or ceremony) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; local van transportation of deceased from place of death; care and custody of deceased; and unscheduled local van transportation to the crematory. The crematory charge, crematory DCA fee, permit fee, and applicable tax are additional and will be estimated or itemized on the Statement of Funeral Goods and Services Selected. Cremation cannot take place until a death certificate is filed and a permit issued by the local county.

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container.

Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The alternative containers we provide are an unfinished fiberboard container and a cloth-covered cardboard container.

Our charge for an immediate burial (**without embalming, casket, viewing, flowers, ceremony, death certificate, permit, or cemetery property**) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; local van transportation of deceased from place of death; care and custody of deceased; unscheduled local van transportation to cemetery. Burial cannot take place until a death certificate is filed and a permit issued by the county.

Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Home

Our charge, without viewing, ceremony, casket, air tray, common carrier charges, or preparation of the body other than embalming, (or if applicable, consulate fees and documents required by consulate or receiving funeral home) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; local van transportation of deceased from place of death; care and custody of deceased; embalming; and unscheduled local van transportation to common carrier. Forwarding cannot take place until a death certificate is filed and a permit issued by the county.

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home

Our charge (without other preparation, casket, viewing, ceremony, common carrier, cemetery, or crematory charges & DCA Fees) includes: basic services of funeral director and staff; local van transportation of deceased from common carrier; care and custody of deceased, and unscheduled local van transportation to cemetery or crematory.
