Guidelines 2026

1. Read and sign the guidelines. Return with the application and a check or submit both application and payment online at www.blackmountainbeautification.org/vendor-26-application. Online payments will include credit card fee. **Deadline: March 15 or when sold out.**
2. **Vendors will be assigned a location & time to set up between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. on Friday, May 15th, 2026.** Booth locations may be adjusted on the day of sale due to unforeseen circumstances. Volunteers will be available to assist in unloading and setting up.
3. Official show hours are from 1:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Friday and 9:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Saturday. Vendors are expected to be at their sites during these times. Once your booth is set up, you can begin to sell even if it is not the official start time. Do not break down until the sale officially ends at 3:30 on Saturday.
4. Items offered for sale should be related to plants, garden art and accessories, and garden literature.
5. Exhibitors must provide all furnishings required for their display. There is a water source at the Town Square Park but you must bring your own containers or hoses.
6. Tents should be weighted and must comply with NFPA requirements for fire resistant quality (the proof will be printed on the tent's label).
7. Vendors are individually responsible for payment of any applicable sales taxes.
8. Sponsors do not assume liability for losses or damages suffered by participants at any time. Participants are responsible for their own liability insurance.
9. In the event of severe weather, the BMBC may reschedule the event.
10. Booth fee refunds cannot be made after the application closing date, March 15, 2026.
