#### 1. California Highway 1: California's Ultimate Coastal Motorcycle Ride

• START/END: Orange County to Mendocino County

ROUTE: HWY 1
DISTANCE: 656 miles
RIDE TIME: 8 hours
BEST TIME: March-May

The section from Monterey to Morro Bay is the best section to ride if you're planning to ride only a portion of it. Ride north-to-south for the ocean on your right and for the easiest way to pull over for the amazing photo opportunities.

As far as timing your ride here, the best time to plan a motorcycle trip is between March–May or September–October because there's a better chance to avoid summer fog and RVs clogging up the road. Also, mud slides and other weather-related factors may cause roadblocks and detours, so check the road conditions on California Highway 1 before planning a ride in 2026.

# 2. Redwood Highway: Best Shaded Forest Motorcycle Ride START/END: Leggett to OR border

ROUTE: US-101 DISTANCE: 192 miles RIDE TIME: 4 hours BEST TIME: May-Oct

The Avenue of the Giants begins in the south near Phillipsville and ends in the north near Pepperwood. This section of road runs parallel to Highway 101 in Humboldt Redwoods State Park, so be sure to take the short detour onto this road —it's a true bucket-list motorcycle ride.

Additionally, the parallel old-growth detour off US-101 feels like riding through a cathedral of redwoods. In 2025, pavement remains excellent with minimal gravel. For the full experience, start in Leggett and head north—pair it with Oregon's continuation for an unbeatable multi-state run.

#### 3. Westgard Pass: Best High-Desert Sierra Motorcycle Ride in California

START/END: Big Pine to NV border

ROUTE: CA-168 DISTANCE: 38 miles RIDE TIME: 1 hour BEST TIME: Apr-June

Westgard Pass offers one of the best motorcycle rides in California for high-desert solitude and sweeping vistas. This underrated 38-mile eastern Sierra gem climbs to 7,313 ft through Inyo National Forest, connecting Owens Valley to Deep Springs.

Because it's the only paved east-west crossing here, traffic stays light year-round. In fact, 2025 repaves have made the curves beautifully smooth for motorcycle riders. Moreover, spring brings wildflowers, while fall delivers golden aspens. Therefore, motorcyclists will want to avoid midday summer heat, which can often exceed 100°F.


#### 4. Klamath River Highway: Northern California's Best Riverside Sweepers

START/END: Happy Camp to I-5

ROUTE: CA-96 DISTANCE: 62 miles RIDE TIME: 1.5 hours BEST TIME: June-Sept

The Klamath River Highway on CA-96 is a great motorcycle road in northern California that can be started from Happy Camp, and it's a winding delight. The Klamath River Highway travels along the second longest river in California, the Klamath River. Overall, the pavement quality is very good, making it a great road for any type of motorcycle. Additionally, there's not much tourist traffic on CA-96 and it's not a major trucking route, so motorcycle riders can open the throttle and enjoy the curves.
