Yesterday, Today, and Always

This year is the 20th anniversary of the attack on the United States on September 1, 2001. The Exchange Clubs of the Valley have been remembering those who perished on that infamous day for the past 17 years. This year the Clubs will host the 9/11 memorial Healing Field at the Tempe Town Lake Park for the 18th year.

The original field of flags presented in Sandy, Utah, was in recognition of the first anniversary of the 9/11 attacks "to acknowledge the magnitude of the loss with a positive image of flags flying, rather than piles of broken concrete and twisted steel." As people visited the display and walked through the rows and rows of thousands of American flags, a "healing" took place, thus the name Healing Field. A year later the Healing Field was presented as an Americanism project for the National Exchange Club. Michael, a member of the Exchange Club of Phoenix, saw the presentation and brought the idea back to the Valley. Several Exchange clubs formed a committee to bring the idea to life. With the assistance of Mayor-Elect Hugh Hallman and the City of Tempe, event became known as the 9/11 Memorial Healing Field. In 2004, the first year of the Tempe Healing Field, there were two fields of flags: the 9/11 Memorial Healing Field had nearly 3000 flags and a Soldiers Field of nearly 1000 flags honoring all the military personnel who had lost their lives in the War on Terror.

The Soldiers Field flags had yellow ribbons attached to the flag poles. The philosophy then was the Soldiers Field might continue to grow so there would never be a need for another Healing Field. The Soldiers Field grew so large that the Tempe Town Lake Park could not contain all the flags. The clubs had to focus their attention to the 9/11 memorial Healing Field. There are almost 3000 American flags representing all those who perished as a result of the attacks that day. The flag poles are on a 5' by 5' grid (you can walk through the Field with arms out stretched and you can touch two lives at once). Each flag pole has a placard with a few words about each person. The first responders' flags are along the perimeter of the Field. The yellow ribbons from the Soldiers Field were moved to the flag poles of the First Responders – they continue to protect and serve.









Over the years, the Clubs have tried to make each year memorable. Stuffed bears were added to the flags poles of the children who perished. Veterans across Valley donated their combat boots to the Field – the combat boots, facing east- are at the base of the veterans' flags.

Sky blue ribbons were added to the aircrew's flag poles and are in the center or heart of the Field. Yard signs, providing datelines, nationalities and other information are posted around the perimeter of the Field to educate visitors. Volunteers will stand up the Field this year on Friday, September 10 at 6:30 a.m. Once the Field is up, more volunteers will dress the flag poles with the placards and ribbons, staffed bears and combat boots. That evening there will be a Freedom Concert to launch the event.

Saturday morning, September 11 at 5:46 a.m. (the first tower strike), there will be a memorial service for the first responders. That evening there will be remembrance service, including special guest speakers and ending with a candlelight ceremony. The Field will stand down on Monday at 6:30 a.m.

The Tempe Healing Field is the second longest consecutive Healing Field in the nation. There are 13 9/11 Healing Fields across the nation this year. President George W. Bush declared 9/11 as Patriots Day. Gary Bird, a Tempe resident, was the only Arizonan to perish in the terrorist attack. Gary was an avid supporter of blood drives; that is why there is a blood drive every year during the Healing Field.

The American flag on the 20-foot pole near the veteran's bridge represents the thousands who have suffered and succumbed as a result of their search and rescue efforts. Thousands more continue to suffer. The stuffed bears in the Field identify the children who died on 9/11; there are 8 stuffed bears. All the combat boots were donated by Valley veterans and their identification card is attached to each combat boot.






