- Call to order at 6:35 pm with prayer by Joyce.
- Approval of minutes from January 22, 2023 meeting.
- Team Reports
 - · Christian Education (Darin)
 - Bible presentation to 3rd and 4th graders March 10
 - Easter Egg hunt Scheduled for Saturday, March 30 at 1:00 pm; plan to hold this in the Church yard, assuming the weather and yard conditions allow. Will want to invite donations of candy (non-chocolate, no nuts) to fill the eggs in the next week. Lexy will ask Dairy Queen and Pizza Ranch if they have any donations they would like to provide for this event, too.
 - Vacation Bible School dates: Monday July 15 through Wednesday July 17.
 - · Finance (Melissa)
 - Available funds as of 1/31/24:
 - Checking Account: \$38,678 (does not include designated funds)
 - Building fund: \$2,684
 - Memorial Fund: \$1,779
 - Dakotas Foundation Investment account: \$170,516
 - Apportionments: Will be paid, per the stipulations listed in January's meeting minutes.
 - Lay Member (Joyce)
 - Sent out 57 membership letters, and have some back. At least one has confirmed to terminate membership. Also sent out 12 Valentine cards and a Thank You card to Katie for her leadership in Christian Ed. Obtained materials for grief education and for encouragement. Have also done 3 visits. Would like to work on getting a history area in the Church. Suggested the possibility of installing a mini-library in the driveway of the Church (similar to what is currently at the City Park or by the Dog Park).

- Staff/Parish Relations (Scott)
 - Finishing up quarterly staff check-ins. No major issues or concerns at this stage.
- Outreach & Missions (Darin; interim)
 - \$1,000 Hunger Grant has been used as a Matching challenge. As of February 29, \$1,400 was sent in to the Food Pantry bringing the total funds raised to \$2,400.
 - Feeding SD April 5th
 - Lunch is Served June 3rd
 - There is a possibility that some of our United Women in Faith can take on some of the mission's responsibility to help free up this role in some way.
 - Would like to participate in the Downtown Farmer's Market in June to help promote VBS.
- Trustees (Jeff)
 - Will discuss best approach for a TV in the HS youth room.
 - Fire alarms Purchased and installed 6 alarms. Approved to purchase 6-8 more, to finish the project.
 - Boiler Insulation installed, East Entry door has been adjusted thanks to Guy Caslin, and Roto Rooter has cleaned out the kitchen drains.
 - Possible projects for this coming month: Reorganize the NW Sunday school room;
 - Air conditioners may be the next major project, though they are not of immediate concern at this stage.
- Worship (Lexy)
 - Lexy will explore the possibility of purchasing Easter banners to continue to update the banners around the building as the seasons change.
 - Lexy will coordinate the purchase of Easter flowers.
 - Camp Sunday Worship this weekend;
 - Holy Week services: Maundy Thursday at 6:30 pm, Good Friday at 6:30 pm, Easter Sunrise at 7:00 am.


