Personal Statement by Pastor Seth

Grace and peace!

For the last month or so I've been facilitating a study on Wednesday evenings on how to manage our time in a Biblical way (I say "facilitate" because it was a study on RightNow Media, and lead by someone much more knowledgable on the subject than myself). It was interesting, and convicting at the same time. I realized in the midst of this study that I am not practicing the kind of healthy time management that I could/should.

For example, I'm not sleeping as much as I should. Instead of getting the 8 hours of sleep that all the science and other research says I need, I choose to do other things like read or mindlessly fiddle with my phone to the point where I maybe get 6 1/2 hours a night. Speaking of my phone, I also allow it to distract me with it's multitude of notifications and alerts, which only serve to pull me out of the task at hand and derail my efforts to be productive.

These are clearly things that are within my control to change, and yet I haven't had the drive or interest to do so. However, after watching this series, I'm wanting to renew my commitment to practicing healthy methods of time management. It won't be easy, so I would welcome any "check-ups" from you to follow-up and see how things are going.

I bring this experience up both to invite your help and support, but also to highlight the resources that helped me spark this interest in self-improvement: Our RightNow Media library of studies, and our Wednesday Adult Bible Study class. RightNow Media is a very helpful resources for anyone interested in Bible studies on a wide variety of topics such as work, parenting, leadership, Bible basics, and even has a huge catalogue of children's programs. All you need an email, and you can access the full database of studies for free as part of the Church's subscription.

I also want to highlight our Wild Wednesday program, and the faith community we are developing there. With a meal at 6:00 pm, a brief worship at 6:30 pm, and classes for all ages and experiences at 6:45 pm, there's an option for everyone. Whether you come for part of the night, or all of it, it's a great chance to grow in community together. And if you choose to join one of our classes, remember that like me, it's never too late to learn something new. Whether you are "experienced' in faith or have a child-like faith, we would love to have you join us and grow with us!


