The front skirt has to come down to THREE inches from the top of the kneecap, just like all other dresses! The chiffon over-layer does not count! What is underneath the chiffon or other over-layer is what will be measured for length.

### BANDAGE/ TUBE DRESSES

- \*There is a difference between fitted and skin tight! The hem of the fitted dress will stay where it is, even when walking and dancing!
- \*The elasticized/tube dresses ride up after any movement! Please DO NOT wear these dresses. They may be the correct length when you put it on, but the first step you take causes this style of dress to inch up your legs.

## TWO-PIECE DRESSES







If you are in doubt, take a picture of yourself in the dress and bring it in to be approved **BEFORE** purchasing it. Save yourself the trouble of shopping twice!

### This is from Mr. Burr, the Activities Director at Brophy, regarding their requirements:

Brophy students and Brophy/Xavier male guests must be in a **collared** shirt and can wear jeans or khaki pants. Shorts are not allowed at the event.

Xavier and Female guests must adhere to the following guidelines:

Capris/appropriate jeans (no rips, shredding or tears)

Modest tops

Skirts or dresses (no shorter than 3 inches from the top of the kneecap)

The following items are NOT allowed for female guests:

Shorts or jean shorts

Strapless tops or dresses

Crop tops/any top which exposes any part of the midriff

Any top or dress that is low cut in the front, back or sides

T-shirts with references to weapons, alcohol, smoking or illegal

substances

T-shirts with vulgar or otherwise inappropriate messages

Any clothing with obvious holes, tears or rips is not allowed; clothing or body adornments that are vulgar or immodest are not allowed by Brophy/Xavier students or their guests.

Brophy/Xavier does have a dress code for Homecoming in the hopes of helping distinguish it from other dances and we will expect you to adhere to it. That being said, feel free to get creative within that dress code. We encourage you to be creative and enjoy the "theme" to be announced soon!

Modesty does not mean that you have to be boring or ugly in the way you present yourself, it means that you understand the value of your body and you want to protect your dignity. It's also not reserved solely for the way you dress... modesty should also be practiced in the way you speak, act, and dance as well. It is an overall lifestyle that affects every aspect of how you live.
