



Formal Dress Information

For our XCP & BCP participants

A special highlight of every Xavier Fashion Show is the Parent Tribute which closes the event. For this portion of the program, the girls are asked to wear a full length gown, like they would for a very special occasion.

There are a few important things to keep in mind as you shop for, or borrow, your dress.

- All dresses must be approved by Dean Macrina.
- Please send an email or bring a photo of you wearing the dress, or the dress itself, to the Dean's office before school, at break, lunch or after school.
- The dress must follow **Xavier's dress code**:
 - Long dress in the color of your choice except white, cream or tan.
 - No asymmetrical hems, high low dresses, or a high low with a sheer cover.
 - Length may be mid-calf (tea length) or ankle (floor length); dress must not drag on the ground.
 - One shoulder, spaghetti strap, and halter (with back) dresses are allowed.
 - No strapless or backless dresses; no excessive cleavage; nothing too revealing.
 - No "see through" or "peek-a-boo" fabrics; no sequined ball gowns or dresses.
 - No slits in the dress.
- **The dress approval deadline is Friday, March 22, 2024.**
- **BCP participants will wear tuxedos.**
