Bay View has no need for another brunch spot. Yet, Sabrosa brings a touch all its own — equal parts bright and hidden, with rotating art installations, and a grand piano that is occasionally played by a co-owner who's a member of the Florentine Opera. The menu straddles the usual comforting bounty of pancakes and Benedicts, big cinnamon rolls, and sausage and gravy, along with Latin-leaning fare like chilaquiles and eggs scrambled with chorizo. There's also a cocktail menu of well-garnished bloodys, and a healthily dangerous orange, mango, vodka, lime, Champagne, and mint concoction. It's a cheery spot to get a daytime buzz.
