- 1. This is a draft horse show. At this time, we are only accepting entries for draft horses. For the purposes of this show, a draft horse includes Clydesdales, Shires, Percherons, Belgians, Gypsies (cob, vanner, drum), Friesians, Fjords, American Cream, Suffolks, Haflingers, Dutch Draft, Boulonnais Horse, Noriker, Spotted Draft and any cross of the above mentioned breeds.
- 2. English Under Saddle classes require proper tack appropriate bridles and saddles for which ever English discipline you are riding under. (dressage, hunter, saddle seat, etc). No martingales allowed in the classes. An approved English helmet or cap/hat (depending on the discipline) are required.
- 3. Western Under Saddle classes same as the English classes. Appropriate tack is required. No tie downs. Dress is appropriate. Jeans and a button up shirt or full western show clothes accepted. Either a helmet or a western hat are appropriate.
- 4. If your horse kicks/bites at other horses, please put the appropriate colored ribbon in his/her tail.
- 5. No person under 18 years of age is permitted to handle or show a stallion.
- 6. We reserve the right to ask any horse/rider/handler to leave the arena at any time for lameness, behavioral issues or improper equipment.
- 7. Tack stalls are available. Please just include that in your stall reservation.
