Farm team entries will pay \$125 per team. We will limit the actual show to 8 teams in the performance. If more than 8 teams enter there will be a draw the night before. Teams who draw 1-8 will be in the performance and all other teams will be in the runoff before the show. All times will be counted the same in the performance and the runoff. Feed team race will be broken into a A/B heat, the top 4 will advance to finals on the last day of the show. All classes will draw the night before as a group to determine order of go each day. The order will be recorded, printed and hung near the start gate. Premium books for farm classes will be emailed to each entry with all rules, payouts and schedule of classes. Each class will have a course sheet that will be emailed to each entry when fees are paid.

Stalls & Shavings:

The \$125/stall fee is for the duration of the show. Check in begins Tuesday, February 27th at 8am and ends Thursday, February 29th at 8am. All horses must be checked in by Thursday, February 29th at 8am, no exceptions. Stall check out is on or before Tuesday, March 5th at 6am.
