Fundraising: <u>Amber Hornbeck</u> reported \$71,000 in sales from this past year's Booster Club fundraising (concession takeover). She reported that merchandise will need to be stocked over the summer. Switching from paper forms for grants, fundraising, requests forms, Secretary report: 10 applications 1300.00 from GTCF, that went to the senior awards night

* **Board report:** Melissa Yeager: President, Vice President <u>Amber Hornbeck</u>: Treasurer, Amy Benum: Fundraiser coordinator: Amber Hornbeck. Secretary: vacant. I Eric make the motion to accept the position as proposed. Diego seconded the motion. The motion passed Year-end review:\$ 7800 for clubs and sports, travel,\$ 6000.00 GK senior (\$4700 went to GK Boosters)

Scholarship criteria: this will be updated on the GK Booster's website soon.

GTC- they wanted GPA removed. Scholarship stacking- do all scholarships under \$600.00 to the actual student: for the preexisting scholarship this year it will continue as is, but next year the GK Booster: will change it to have the checks sent to the student. The applicant will need a letter of recommendation, change it to Google form, and the essay will stay the same. Trade schools and military applicants will be able to apply for scholarship monies too.

Booster scholarship award: Booster's took over concession in Fall 2023- this will be new criteria for concession scholarship monies. A minimum of 20 hours worked in their senior year or 40 hours over the 4 years of their high school career. Complete the online application, Google Documents.
