# Somebody Had an Epiphany

*God who said 'Let light shine out of darkness' has shown in our hearts the light of knowing God's glory shown forth in the face of Jesus Christ.*

-2 Corinthians 4:6

What a pity. We have reduced the journey of the Magi to 'We Three Kings' and a bathrobe-style Christmas pageant.

This Sunday we will be celebrating the **Epiphany of our Lord**. We take time to focus on the REAL

meaning of the Magi (aka those 'Three Kings') coming to Jesus.

For our purposes the word **EPIPHANY** basically has two meanings.

First, on a purely human level an epiphany can be a sparking illumination of something previously unknown. 'The light bulb goes on.'

Second, is epiphany with a capital 'E' preceded by a definite article hence: **THE EPIPHANY**.

The ***Epiphany of our Lord*** is the gracious gift to these Magi 'pagan gentiles' if you will: It is the revelation that the Bethlehem child would bring the good news, light, hope and salvation, not just to Israel but to the whole world!


The title of this week's message is **Epiphanies and THE Epiphany**. Our text is 2 Corinthians 4:1-6 and it's worth a read.

To start the New Year 2026 off right, we will gather to receive the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper.
