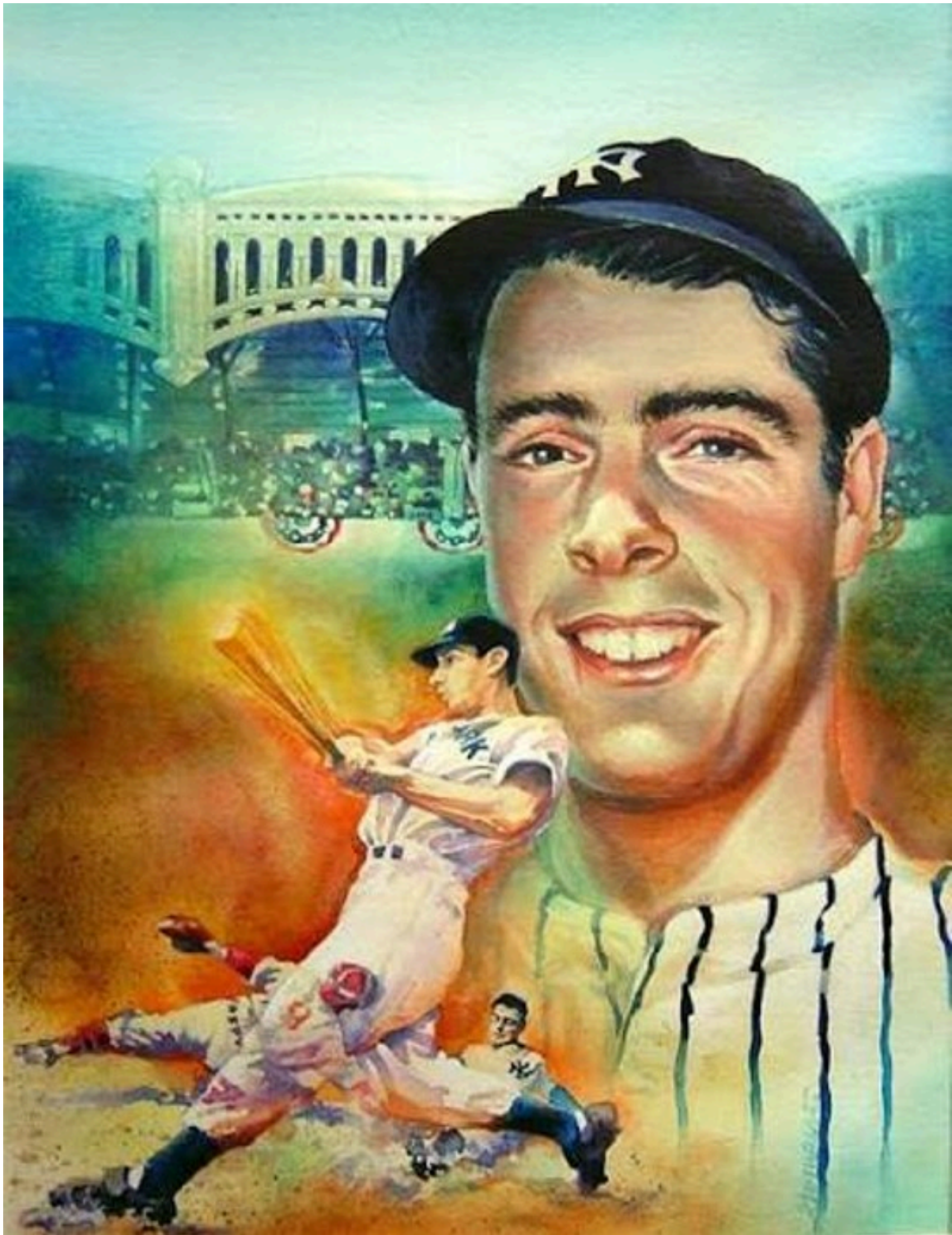


Where Have You Gone Joe DiMaggio?

This Sunday we conclude a 'mini-series' leading up to the celebration of America 250.
