

RESTORED IS A 'MANY SPLENDORED' THING

He restores my soul... Psalm 23:3

As we continue in our current preaching series, **A SUMMER WITH THE SHEPHERD** we'll examine those four words "He restores my soul." Two ideas immediately flood my mind. The first idea is for the 'heavenly minded' and the second is, well... for the rest of us.

The first brings to mind one of the grandest lyrics penned in

English hymnody. If you have sung 'Praise My Soul the King of Heaven' then you have come across these whack-you-across-the-face words: 'RANSOMED, HEALED, **RESTORED**, FORGIVEN ever more God's praises sing!' In flowing language, it describes all that God has so generously done for us in Christ. What a magnificent kingdom portrait!

But for the rest of us who are a bit 'earthier.' Restore simply means to fix what is broken and put it back the way it should be.

Many of you know three years ago I had several back surgeries. And praise God now I can say I am 100%.
