



‘HE LEADS ME’ DOWN....THE PRIMROSE PATH?

He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

Psalm 23:3

Having heard of the expression and used the words ‘primrose path’ repeatedly all my life, I can honestly say I never really knew what it meant.

According to the *Cambridge Dictionary*, to lead someone down the primrose path is to encourage them to ‘live a life that appears to be full of pleasure but ultimately destructive.’

An instant thought: There’s got to be a sermon in there somewhere!’

It's often said becoming a Christian—receiving Christ as Savior and Lord—may be simple but it's never easy. Boy, is that true.

Which brings us to the next line of Psalm 23 for this Sunday's message: *He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake* as we continue in our series **A SUMMER WITH THE SHEPHERD.**

Many well-meaning believers say 'come to Jesus and he will solve all your problems.' Certainly, that's true in the sense of our need for forgiveness and eternal salvation. Let me quickly add that once you received Christ *you have a whole new set of problems [er, I mean challenges] to deal with!*

This week's message deals with the Lord *leading us in paths of righteousness for his name's sake.* An apropos question might be: *Does He Leads Me Down the Primrose Path?* Trust me, the answer to that one may appear simple but it's not easy. But it is infinitely better than any imaginary primrose path.

And while you're thinking on this, you might want to check out Proverbs 3:1-10 and John 16:7-14 for back up. It's what we'll be looking at in our determination to follow the leading of our Lord.
