A refreshing renovation to an out dated community pool area has created an exciting water park with a new slide tower feature, Zerodepth entrance wading pool with nineteen interactive features including an Aqua Arch, Mushroom Maze, Over N Under, a Pop Drop, and a large, interactive play feature with a tipping bucket.

Design and Construction began at the end of Fall 2008. The pool opened to the public on May 25, 2009. Project delivered on time, in budget, as planned.
