WHAT THE ASSOCIATION ACCOMPLISHED IN 2023

- Due to the long rainy season lasting for most of the year, many roofs needed repair.
- Purchased a new golf cart.
- Many fences had to be repaired or sections replaced throughout the year because of rotting and warping.
- Several homes needed stucco repairs.
- Playground gate was repaired due to broken lock.
- Gate behind the clubhouse repaired as over time the space where it closed became wide enough for people to squeeze through.
- Pool heater needed rewiring separating it from main breaker box inside clubhouse as the heater breaker kept shutting off.
- The state found several pool violations which were omitted by the pool company that renovated the pool. This was not cost to us.
- Board of Directors approved changing insurance brokers beginning immediately.
- Signed a rental agreement with Epson for an all-in-one printer which includes ink free at a big savings over our old printer.
- Replaced one tennis court net



TENNIS COURT NETS

NEW GARBAGE BINS

BULK TRASH

By putting your trash at the curb days prior to Wednesday pickup make those areas unpleasant to look at for days on end. The Rules & Regulations stipulate that trash is to be put at the curb only on Tuesdays after 4 PM. See Rule #10 attached.

HOA RULES & REGULATIONS

Attached is an updated document. This document contains the most common violated rules and are abridged from our governing documents for easy reading. For obvious reasons this document is not all inclusive and represents only some of the rules. Please read in the near future. Knowing what these say can prevent you from doing something that will cause a violation especially if you are thinking of adding or subtracting anything to/from your property. For example, many homeowners have installed a 6' shed, which is prohibited because it can be a hurricane hazard, and have had to remove it. Also an Architectural Request must be submitted to the office for approval for any changes to the outside of your property. (Rule #13) This is to assure that the overall look of the association stays consistent. Another example is parking on the grass. At no time is that allowed by homeowners or their visitors and that vehicle is subject to towing. No overnight parking on the street is allowed and cars parked on the street must be moved by 10PM nightly. (Rule #4). No window air conditioners are allowed.
