Beach Rules

- Beach Permit must accompany all visitors to the Beach.
- Cars in parking area must have beach permit visible.
- Children 13 and under must be accompanied by an Adult 18 years or older.
- No Pets on beach.
- No Glass on the beach.
- No Fishing in the swim area.
- No Fires or Gas Grills on the beach.
- No Smoking on the beach or in picnic area.
- No Climbing on storage racks, trees or fence.
- No Watercraft allowed in swim area.
- Groups of 20 or more need to notify the association 1 week in advance.
- Groups of 20 or more need to supply a portable restroom for their guest.
- Trash Carry in Carry out only.

No Life Guard on Duty – Swim at your own Risk

Boat Rules

- Boat permit must be visible on watercraft and stored and locked on or near the boat rack or other stationary object, such as a tree to the far left or right of the beach.
- During foul weather (Hurricanes or High Wind) we recommend removal of watercraft from beach.
- Unpermitted watercraft left on the beach overnight are subject to removal at the owners' expense.
- All watercraft must be removed from beach on or before December 1.

Types of watercraft allowed to be stored:

- Kayaks, canoes, rowboats(if previously granted) (12 foot max length)
- Paddleboats and sailboats (if previously granted) (14 foot max length)
