## How to gain approval for construction of an out-building or deck:

Out-buildings are structures that are not attached to your residence. Most common examples are garages, car/boat ports, storage sheds, gazebos and free-standing decks. The Association rules expressly limit the size of garages/sheds on a lot without a house, to less than 150 square feet. This guidance is also for adding a deck attached to a residence.

**Prior To Construction:** the following items must be submitted to the Environmental Control Committee (ECC) for review. While not required, electronic submissions are preferable.

- <u>Site Plan</u>: the site plan is a drawing of the planned layout of the structure on the lot. The site plan must:
  - a. Be drawn on a copy of the plat of the lot. A copy of the plat may be obtained from the County Clerk's office for a nominal fee.
  - b. Show all dimensions of the lot, including distances from the structure to front, back and sides of lot (Note: Pine Harbour requires all structures to be set back at least 60 feet from road <u>easement</u> line, 25 feet from the rear lot line and 10 feet from each side lot line).
  - c. Show approximate locations of any other existing structures (house, garage, etc.) and existing or proposed driveway.
- <u>Building Plans</u>: one copy of the building plans being used for construction. If structure is to be delivered fully assembled (e.g. a shed), you should submit all information available.
- <u>Material Samples</u> that are the same material and color as the siding, trim, and roof that will be on the structure. Pictures of good quality may be submitted instead.

**Staking of lot**: location of the structure must be staked and taped prior to approval.

<u>Trees</u>: removal of trees for out-building construction shall be limited to those within the boundaries of the structure and those within 20 feet from the approved site. Additional trees over 6 inches in diameter MUST be approved by the ECC <u>before</u> removal.

**Review Time**: the ECC shall review and approve or disapprove 30 days from receipt.
