Artwork Submissions

Each artist may submit up to 10 pieces total with the \$25 fee as follows:

- Up to **7 framed pieces**, MUST BE wired and ready to hang
- Up to 3 unframed pieces, in protective plastic sleeves for display in bins

All artwork and completed forms must be submitted by **Friday at 4:00 PM, one week before the show.** No late entries will be accepted.

- Original Work Only: No reproductions will be accepted.
- Framed Art Size Limit: Maximum size is 36" x 36" (including frame).
- Large Art Consideration: Due to limited wall space, larger pieces require preapproval. Email a photo and dimensions to **midlandpaletteclub@gmail.com** with subject line: LARGE ART REQUEST FOR ART SHOW & SALE.
- Framing Standards: All framed art must be securely framed with a wire hanger. (No alligator clips, sawtooth hangers, etc.)
- Unframed Art: Must be placed in a clear plastic sleeve/envelope for display in bins.
