

## Updated details regarding April 2025

In the first days of April 2025, The Judahite considered the unfolding prophetic days in April.

While standing with a red marker in his left hand,



it changed to black. Yes, the black marker became like the four other black markers on the shelf. ( $4 + 1 = 5$ ) Changing colors in this instance was supernatural!

### What is the interpretation?

(Disregard the twenty-fourth calendar day in the graphic.)

Zechariah 6:1-8 gives the correct interpretation. In review:

- “And I turned, and lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and, behold, there came four chariots out from between two mountains; and the mountains *were* mountains of brass.
- With the first chariot *were* red horses, with the second chariot black horses,
- with the third chariot white horses, and with the fourth chariot dappled horses—strong *steeds*. Then I answered and said to the angel who talked with me, “What *are* these, my lord?”
- And the angel answered and said unto me, These are the four winds of heaven, which go forth from standing before the Lord of all the earth.
- The one with the black horses is going to the north country, the white are going after them, and the dappled are going toward the south country.”
- As the dappled horses came out, they were impatient to go and inspect the earth. The angel said, "Go and inspect the earth!"--and they did.
- And he cried out and spoke to me, saying, Behold, these go out to the land of the north, and they have quieted mine anger in the land of the north.

There has been much speculation about the red horse for over a thousand years. The central debate is whether prophecy has been fulfilled or whether eschatology is the answer.



The Holy Spirit revealed to The Judahite the interconnection of the two missions. The judgmental event is now. The Vision of the Four Chariots offers layers of understanding.

Briefly, the focus is on five black horses. A heavy load of judgmental pain is around the corner.

**The heavenly court has established the next layer, Judahtocracy;** therefore, there is no basis for compromising. So, in that context, anyone going against the Executive Body of Israel in Exile is viewed by the heavenly court as rebellious.

Biblically, it is well established to go against the authority of heaven is an act of rebellion. It is better to obey than to make sacrifices or make substitution for ulterior motives.

Rebellion has also been known as the spirit of witchcraft. Consider 1 Samuel 15:23:

- For rebellion *is as* the sin of witchcraft, And stubbornness *is as* iniquity and idolatry. Because you have rejected the word of the LORD, He also has rejected you from *being* king.”
