# Second Heaven's message, the approaching famine

About an hour later, without thunder and lightning, there was another blackout. Somewhere, the weather conditions cut the flow of electricity to the neighborhood. Without power, nothing works except for battery-powered electronic portable devices with limited power sources.

The smoke detector and fire alarm lights went out because the unit is hardwired, and there are no batteries. Regardless, the monitoring unit chirping sound occurred continuously. Why? Under normal conditions, the chirping sound indicates a low battery, but the reality moment was abnormal. Still, the chirping sound retains its meaning to indicate draining energy applicable to tribal Judah having met his historical tasks requirement for transitioning.
