April 20, 2024 PASSOVER

April 20 appeared before Judahite distinctly from commonly transmitted dates. This peculiarity suggests a divine priority, a significance that is not to be overlooked. Yet it also maintains its place in the sequence of number dates, further emphasizing its importance in our religious journey.

Date issues

Over twelve years, The Judahite has followed a path guided by the Holy Spirit and the Courts of Heaven, negating traditional dates. The journey has led to a significant development. The dispersed tribe of Judah is now being gathered from earth's four corners. This gathering is a momentous event, a testament to our unity and shared beliefs. The Ten Tribes are also coming together, and the 144,000 have been sealed, marking a new chapter in our collective spiritual journey.

End times events materializing in real-time for those in the select category can grasp. The Judahite's presentations over the years and currently give guidelines for the Congregation to understand as we move from one evolutionary level to the next, the era of quantitative occurrences, before all processes reach their final stage of maturity, leading to a qualitative social reality—a revolutionary leap where the new dominates the old social order of society.

As a predecessor before April 20, the Feast of Leavened Bread replaced the Feast of Unleavened Bread. The Judahite discussed the new feast's doctrine in a previous presentation.

Easter vs. Passover

The Judahite is fully aware of the existing confusion involved in the Congregation's separation from the heathens and followers of Satan.

Easter is rooted in paganism, a practice coopted by the Church of Rome.

The Passover originated in the last plague that hit Egypt hours before the exodus, the gateway to the new nation-state of Israel.

Passover

The Israelites received instructions hours before departing Egypt. They were to eat lamb meat for one meal, burn the leftovers, prepare and eat unleavened bread, and pack and dress to leave at midnight.

Additionally, paint lamb blood on the outside door as notice for the death angel to skip over household members of the firstborn.

When considering the cognitive levels of Passover, which emerged over thousands of years, the meaning and purpose of Passover is about the salvation of Israel through the death and resurrection of Yeshua as a precondition for the righteous Gentiles' salvation.

Passover's new calendar date

April 20 is the new Passover date. The Congregation will observe the date throughout the millennium. The Feast of Passover will last six and half days or 6 1/2.

Rules

Yeshua's practices, which hold significant importance, now form the new rule and principles for guiding ceremonial practices as the Congregation continues its transition to the Promised Land. These rules and the New Testament Practices are currently under review, following the Court's adjudicated results from the previous week.

- 1. Eat leavened bread.
- 2. Everyone must purify and sanctify their body with hair regulations.
- 3. The Passover Feast will last 6 ½ days. With a conference on the last day.

As a footnote, the new tradition prohibits drinking alcoholic beverages during the Feast days. However, vodka is permitted for those already inclined to drink. The ideal drink would be a bloody Mary. The name association is in keeping with liberation, the ending of bondage; hence, a Bloody Sunday—vodka with a mixture of fine tomatoes and spices.

April 25 ends the Passover Feast.
