Apostle Paul vs Babylonian Talmud and Judaism

This presentation is one case in a series on prophetic relationships that the Congregation of Israel has as friends and foes.

The targeted focus is on the current state of the Israelis. There is a tremendous amount of anxiety in the state of Israel, knowing that the prophetic gathering of Judah from the earth's four corners is now pending and so, imminently, their displacement.

The spirit moves. Weeks ago, the people of Israel took to the streets every day for three to four weeks protesting judicial reform. From the people's perspective, they want to go forward, not stay in the past. Seeing hundreds of thousands of people in the streets every day and night is a sign of pending prophetic changes.

On August 29, 2023, The Judahite once again received Raphael's indicium for our times in Ezekiel chapters 23 and 24.

A brief outline follows to understand where the ax will fall on the Israelis to make way for Judah and the Executive Body of Israel in Exile.

The Evolutionary Background of Judaism or the Babylonian Talmud

Ezekiel, the Magistrate Judge's:

Findings, Facts, and Sanctions

- So, he brought me to the door of the court; and when I looked, there was a hole in the wall.
 Ezekiel 8:7
- Then He said to me, "Son of man, dig into the wall"; and when I dug into the wall, there was a door. 8:8
- And He said to me, "Go in, and see the wicked abominations which they are doing there."
 8:9
- So I went in and saw, and there—every sort of creeping thing, abominable beasts, and all the
 idols of the house of Israel, portrayed all around on the walls. 8:10
- And there stood before them seventy men of the elders of the house of Israel, and in their midst stood Jaazaniah the son of Shaphan. Each man had a censer in his hand, and a thick ODOUR cloud of incense went up. 8:11
- Then He said to me, "Son of man, have you seen what the elders of the house of Israel do
 in the dark, every man in the room of his idols? For they say, "The LORD does not see us.
 The LORD has forsaken the country." 8:12
- And He said to me, "Turn again, and you will see greater abominations that they are doing."
 8:13
- So, he brought me into the inner court of the LORD's house; and there, at the door of the temple of the LORD, between the porch and the altar, *were* about twenty-five men with their backs toward the temple of the LORD and their faces toward the east, and they were worshiping the sun toward the east. Ezekiel 8:16

The Ruling

First, as supplemental information, Moses ascended and descended from Mt. Sinia to the base camp of Israel to fashion the laws for a holy people and their nation. Mt. Sinia is the Supreme Court or the High Court, not the Magistrate's Court.

The elders of the House of Israel is an office title assigned to the twelve patriarchal tribes of Israel bestowed during the children's stay in Egypt. Although the seventy members of governance, the elders, ascended Mt. Sinia, they went to the Second Heaven, where they were in the presence of the LORD and ate and drank (Exodus 24:9 & 10).

Moses made a distinction between the High Court and Second Heaven clear. Following Moses's moves, he told his delegation of seventy to stay, say, 2/3 the distance while he went up in a cloud. Later, he came back down, and they went up together.

The instruction to the office of elders: <u>killing people is not required to please Elohim</u>. The inaugural meal served as the Holy People's commemoration to personally KNOW their God by following his laws and performing ceremonial requirements—a clear distinction from heathen nations.

The office of Seventy Elders seen by Ezekiel in the idolatry temple of darkness is the same spirit present in the Second Heaven at the inaugural meal. The importance of the Seventy Elders is linked to the Babylonian Talmud.

20:1 "And it came to pass in the seventh year, in the fifth month, the tenth day of the month, that certain of the elders of Israel came to enquire of the LORD and sat before me."

"Will you judge them, son of man, will you judge them? Then make known to them the abominations of their fathers."

- "Son of man, speak to the ancients of Israel, and say to them: Thus, saith the Lord God: Are you come to inquire of me? As I live, I will not answer you, saith the Lord God." Ezekiel 20:3
- 20:7 "Then I said to them, 'Each of you, throw away the abominations which are before his eyes, and do not defile yourselves with the idols of Egypt. I am the LORD your God."
- 20:8 But they rebelled against Me and would not obey Me. They did not all cast away the abominations which were before their eyes, nor did they forsake the idols of Egypt. Then I said, 'I will pour out My fury on them and fulfill My anger against them in the midst of the land of Egypt.'
- 20:9 But I acted for My name's sake, that it should not be profaned before the Gentiles among whom they were, in whose sight I had made Myself known to them, to bring them out of the land of Egypt.
- 20:11 And I gave them My statutes and showed them My judgments, 'which, if a man does, he shall live by them.'
- 20:12 Moreover I gave them also my sabbaths, to be a sign between me and them: and that they might know that I am the Lord that sanctify them.

Forty years in the wilderness reduced 80% practicing Egyptians' idol religion.

- > 20:16 Because they despised my judgments, and walked not in my statutes, but polluted my sabbaths: for their heart went after their idols
- 20:17 Nevertheless mine eye spared them from destroying them, neither did I make an end of them in the wilderness.

In part, Dan (his mother Bilhah Rachel's handmaid) adopted Rachel's father's gods. Rachel brought the idols into Canaan, hidden in her luggage. One bad apple spoils the bunch. Dan's rebelliousness became transgenerational, supported by those nations that practiced the gods of Egypt, Babylonian, and the Canaanites.

- 20:18 But I said unto their children in the wilderness, walk ye not in the statutes of your fathers, neither observe their judgments, nor defile yourselves with their idols:
- > 20:19 I am the LORD your God. walk in my statutes, and keep my judgments, and do them; 20:20 And hallow my sabbaths; and they shall be a sign between me and you, that ye may know that I am the LORD your God.

Hell-bent hearts of disobedience. The LORD turned their gifts into pollution.

- a.) "I let them defile themselves with their own offerings, and I let them sacrifice their first-born sons."
- b.) Upon entering the Promised Land, "they saw every high hill, and all the thick trees, and they offered there their sacrifices, and there they presented the provocation of their offering: sweet savor and poured out there their drink offerings."
- c.) High places/Grove. "For they also built them altars, and statues, and groves upon every high hill and under every green tree." 1 Kings 14:23 ("There were even male shrine prostitutes in the land.")

Affirmative! Do not seek the will of God.

- 20:31 Even today you offer the same gifts and defile yourselves with the same idols by sacrificing your children to them in the fire. And then you Israelites still come to ask what my will is! As surely as I, the Sovereign LORD, am the living God, I will not let you ask me anything.
- 20:39 The Sovereign LORD says, "And now, all you Israelites, suit yourselves! Go on and serve your idols! But I warn you that after this you will have to obey me and stop dishonoring my holy name by offering gifts to your idols.

Judaism, Babylonian Talmud, Kabbah, Zionism, etc., are no more than branches of the rebelliousness of the seventy elders.

Saul came from Judaism. On his way to Damascus, Yeshua blinded him for three days. In his blindness, he could see Christ. "I warn you that, you will have to obey me after this."

Apostle Paul re-entered the bond of Covenant. Apostle Paul, upholding the New Testament, negated Judaism, Babylonian Talmud, Kabbah, Zionism, etc.

August 29, 2023 The Parable of the Bolling Pot

On August 29, 2023, The Judahite once again received Raphael's indicium for our times in Ezekiel chapters 23 and 24. Ezekiel's chapter 20 gives the Evolutionary Background of the Babylonian Talmud or Judaism.

However, in chapter 24, the death of Ezekiel's wife is a prophecy about what will happen to Judaism and those of the transgenerational spirit of rebellion against the New Testament.

Dramatically, Raphael illustrated the Parable of the Bolling Pot before The Judahite.

Step one. ²⁴³ And utter a parable unto the rebellious house, and say unto them, thus saith the Lord GOD; Set on a pot, set it on, and also pour water into it."

Step two. ²⁴⁻⁴ Gather the pieces thereof into it, even every good piece, the thigh, and the shoulder; fill it with the choice."

On August 31, 2023, the illustration continued.

Step three. ^{24:10} Heap on wood, kindle the fire, consume the flesh, and spice it well, and let the bones be burned.

Step four. ^{24:11} Then set it empty upon the coals thereof, that the brass of it may be hot, and may burn, and that the filthiness of it may be molten in it, that the scum of it may be consumed.

A Plan of Action for the Israelis

For those who are ready to turn their face to God like Paul, you should take to the streets by the thousands with signs reading:

Ezekiel's reaction to his wife's death will be our model.
