**Pentecost's prescribed Rule of Conduct that will be followed,
As the Congregation continues to transition to the Lands of Promise.**

May 21 is the prophetic day of Pentecost, and May 27 is the traditional Pentecost; both days will be observed as done over the years.

From a historical perspective,

- ^{28:20} *And Jacob vowed a vow, saying, If God will be with me, and will keep me in this way that I go, and will give me bread to eat, and raiment to put on,*
- *And I shall return prosperously to my father's house: the Lord shall be my God: And this stone, which I have set up for a title, shall called the house of God: and of all things that thou shalt give to me, I will offer tithes to thee. Genesis 28:20-22*

“The Lord shall be my God.”

The legal pledge, the foundational protocol, has been upheld three times in Congregational history. The fourth pledge will confirm adherence to Yeshua's New Covenant.

1. Jacob made his vow before the Magistrate at Bethel. After his return to his father's land, and after Levi and Simone demonstrated rejecting Shechem's paganistic lifestyle by killing all the men in the city for violating Dinah, Jacob went to Bethel to make a sacrifice to the LORD for having honored his vow.
2. The Children of Israel departed Egypt going to the Holy Land. Before arrival, they received the Ten Commandments and learned of the religious procedures to live a morally wholesome life. Once in the Holy Land, they constructed Temple. Later, the Congregation sinned. Society collapsed due to rampant social injustice, not following the LAW, and spiritual corruption inside the Temple. The Temple had to be destroyed. Jeremiah received the appointment to oversee the demolition.
3. The Babylonian Exile. Seventy-Years-Exile. At the end of seventy years, Daniel offered a supplication for the sins of Israel and Judah. In Babylon, Judah received the blueprint of history. Before Israel could express the fullness of their religion, four Gentiles' social systems would appear and disappear. Yeshua's New Testament has continuously put on restrictions as seen in the fourth Gentiles' society. As foretold to Daniel, the Righteous one would appear and end to sacrifice, Yeshua. With this eschatological knowledge, the exiles returned to Judea to reconstruct the Temple and society.

4. Yeshua arrived in the appropriate season. He established the New Covenant for the Congregation. Still, the conflict between the Serpent's seed and Adam's descendants would continue.
 - But God found fault with the people and said: "Behold, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah. Hebrews 8:8.
5. In AD 70, as foretold, Judah would go back into captivity, and the city of Jerusalem and the Temple would be destroyed.
6. Again, after prophetic Seventy-Years-Exile, Judah, and Israel are preparing to return to the Lands of Promise.
 - "This is the covenant I will make with them after those days," declares the Lord. I will put My laws in their hearts and inscribe them on their minds." Hebrews 10:16
Then He adds: "Their sins and lawless acts I will remember no more." Hebrews 10:17

**Given Calendar dates are to enrich
prescribed rules of conduct to follow in transitioning.**

Procedurally, before the exiles return to the father's land with wealth, the doctrinal core for the new social life requires fashioning; upon arriving home, the rules of conduct will become consolidated.

Take notice: offensive moral behavior, generally accepted and legalized in our society and many places worldwide will have no place in the Commonwealth of Israel. Thus, prepare to go elsewhere to live.
