## Reporting

The Judahite received the Second Heaven's two Indicants Early in the morning, having an implementation **Order** on Ezekiel chapters 24 and 25.

Ezekiel gives a dual prophecy regarding the fall of Jerusalem. In Ezekiel 33:12, the Elohim told him two years before the fall of Jerusalem to expect an escapee from Jerusalem to bring him news about the fulfillment of his prophecy. Ezekiel 24:26 received forehand information on who would bring him predictive news. In the meantime, Ezekiel sealed his lips and ears regarding the definitive forecast of Jerusalem's demise.

- “And it came to pass in the twelfth year of our captivity, in the tenth month, on the fifth day of the month, that there came to me one that was fled from Jerusalem, saying: The city is laid waste.” Ezekiel 33:12

### A prophecy for our times:

- “In that day, I say, shall thy mouth be opened to him that hath escaped, and thou shalt speak, and shalt be silent no more: and thou shalt be unto them for a sign of things to come, and you shall know that I am the Lord.” 24:27

## Putting it together

### Terms

- (1) The escapee= 70 A.D. Judah.
- (2) Remnant of Judah= December 2017, the night of the full moon, each night The Judahite's carpet rug moved away from his bed.
- (3) Jerusalem recognized as the capital of Israel. On December 6, the U.S. President announced moving the U.S. Embassy to Jerusalem.
- (4) The 1947 United Nations' Partition Resolution 181 recognized Israel as a state; hence, the Horn of Israel. Compared to Daniel's Little Horn (the Vatican/Pope), Napoleon delivered the fatal blow to the Papacy. Still, the Papacy was later resurrected by the Freemasons and the Jesuits after being forced to agree to give up all claims to Temporal Power, which the Jesuits would claim. Temporal Power means exercising political authority over state governmental authority. On the other hand, Judaism represents aspects of the Old

Testament. **The pure contextual Law of Moses is recognized as the Horn.** Judaism is a hypocritical philosophy, yet Judaism underlines the importance of latter-day prophecies regarding the reestablishment of Israel and the regathering of Judah from the four corners of the world, as discussed in the Five Books of the Old Testament. Hence, the (seed) budding—making way for the whole house of exiled Israelites to return home to the Holy Land.

- *“In that day will I cause a horn to bud forth unto the house of Israel, and I will give thee the opening of the mouth in the midst of them; and they shall know that I am the LORD.”*  
Ezekiel 29:21

(5) Jeremiah’s Seventy Years prophecy commenced in 1947, appearing as Ezekiel’s sign of the **horn**. In the two staged procedures directing the Fall of Babylonian, The Judahite appeared in the first stage of the Seventy Years’ prophecy to exercise prophetic jurisdiction over Israel, allowing the 70 A.D. descendant (Judah) escapee to reiterate Ezekiel 24 to the rebellious house of Israel or those in the state of Israel in 2017.

- “In that day, I say, shall thy mouth be opened to him that hath escaped, and thou shalt speak, and shalt be silent no more: and thou shalt be unto them for a sign of things to come, and you shall know that I am the Lord.”  
Ezekiel 24:27

#### In perspective

Ezekiel, acting as the Magistrate, ruled in favor of the degenerative behavior of the rebels. The LORD God of Israel cut off communication with those Israelites embracing Babylonian Talmud or Judaism. Free to go your way. In reaction to the judicial ruling, Judaism hates Yeshua and the New Testament teaching, which is the covenant between Jesus and those believing in him.

The Executive Body of Israel in Exile has notified Jerusalem of Judah’s pending return. Indeed, the Israeli government has received notices of Judah’s pending return home over the past three years.

**Thousands of years later, the rebellious house of Israel is still holding firm.**

- *Jerusalem, your immoral actions have defiled you. Although I tried to purify you, you remained defiled. You will not be pure again until you have felt the full force of my anger. Ezekiel 24:13*
- *All are hardened rebels, walking around as slanderers. They are bronze and iron; all of them are corrupt. Jeremiah 6:28*

**Likewise, the LORD reaffirms’ his ruling. What gives?**

Ezekiel tells us:

- Now the evening before the fugitive (Judah) arrived, the hand of the LORD was upon me, and He opened my mouth before the man came to me in the morning. So, my mouth was opened, and I was no longer mute.  
Ezekiel 33:22
- “I the Lord have spoken, it shall come to pass, and I will do it: I will not pass by, nor spare, nor be pacified: I will judge thee according to thy ways, and according to thy doings, saith the Lord.”  
Ezekiel 24:14
