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Passover's Extended Summary

PASSOVER is a religious doctrinal philosophy; we, the Israelites, were given this Feast Day of physical enslavement in contrast to programmed spirituality of the highest order. As a background, Egypt was known as the land of gods during the Israelites' enslavement in Egypt.

Days before Israel became a nation-state, the law of singularity embodied the nation of Israel. God encompasses his created people, which were to stand out from other national religions.
