Babylonian and the Chaldeans are presented as united yet subject to different judgments. In origin, the Babylonian Empire incorporated a religious doctrine that involve astrological deities as a state religion known as the Chaldeans. State religion is the focus of attention. For example, during the Holy Roman Empire, the Pope approved of Kings to carry out political and military decisions. Consider the Church of England, it has the same ideal with a different outward presentation.

At the time of King Nebuchadnezzar, the Chaldeans, an occult power center, managed the Empire as the wise men because they learned the signs in the sky and of the heavens, telling of earthly problems.

Contrary to the notion about the Assyrians and Babylon empires of antiquity existed in separation, the gods of Egypt and Sumer were of one religious system despite different geographical divisions and kingdoms.

Very few people asked questions about the divine drama and theatrics of Babylon during the time of Daniel. The book of Daniel is clear in presenting historical facts. Nothing herein is being added, only giving appropriate points of emphasis.

Like many kings before King Nebuchadnezzar, he assumed the Chaldeans possessed an exclusive right to know everything. Truly, they knew everything about giving timely warnings to kings that adversely affected intertwining interests, permanently preserving their power center within government.

Yahawah demonstrated to Daniel and the King that he was superior to all deities known in Sumer and Egypt.

Knowing and not knowing, the Chaldeans could not retrieve the King's dream from his memory bank. Because they could not, the King ordered the Chaldeans killed. Daniel requested a stay within the hour of execution, which the King granted.

To kill all was an outrageous act of political suicide. Yet, the King was willing to commit political suicide. As seen throughout history and today, Kings and government officials, under self-illusions, accept personalized death invitations from the devil to be killed or murdered.

The enduring antagonistic relationship between the Chaldeans and the Judahites.

- 1. Daniel and his three associates told the King about his dream and interpretation. By doing so, Daniel and his three associates defeated the Chaldeans universally.
- 2. To get back at Daniel and his three associates, they conspired against the three associates, leading to a fiery furnace drama. Cosmic and universally, the fire killed some of the Chaldeans as they were making the fire seven times hotter.
- 3. The King decreed people disrespecting Daniel's God in public would be killed. For the first time in history, the Chaldeans were constrained under statutory control by death.
- 4. The King of the Chaldeans hosted a global conference in Babylon where he elevated himself above Daniel's God by taking the Temple of Jerusalem's religious utensils for secular partying to his gods.
- 5. Belshazzar, King of the Chaldeans, knew about Nebuchadnezzar's decree granting statutory retribution to offenders of Daniel's God. Yet, he committed political suicide, motivated by being the King with the right to select which laws to enforce. The Magistrate of heaven issued the sentencing ORDER on the wall for all to see, telling the King and the Chaldeans divine laws are beyond them and will be enforced.
- 6. Continuing with the organic dynamics between the Judahites and the Chaldeans, Daniel became the third king of Babylon. And within an hour, the King was executed.
- 7. Conspiratorial by nature, the Chaldeans ensured all their bases were covered for putting Daniel away once and for all—death without being implicated. Under the Medes and Persian Empire, they planned Daniel's demised carefully and perfectly executed. They ambushed Daniel, knowing he would break their law by going to his room to pray, which landed him into the lion's den.
- 8. Again, the organic dynamics between Daniel, the Judahite, and the Chaldeans illustrate Nebuchadnezzar's decree, a divine law, is enforceable to the third and fourth generations.

The Chaldeans' Core Competency is Conspiratorial

When studying the Babylonian Chaldeans, we see the conspiratorial practices under a law against the Judeans. The same core competency under the Medes and Persian Empire grew into a coherent system, the **ideal** to take legal wealth generated by tribal Judah for their own use in the service of their gods.

The IDEAL in composition involves the prosecution of Daniel under national law by the lawyers, who are wise men. Restudying Daniel's episode in the lion's den, we see the time when the Chaldeans consolidated their core competency of ruling through secrecy.

Thus, Jeremiah prophesized against Babylon and the Chaldeans. He knew the Chaldean Ideal oppressive instruments against Judah would be fully understood through the exposition of Daniel in the lion's den. Like in the past, today, the Chaldeans have the attached divine curse of liquidation when in conflict with Judah.
