Eighth Day of January

As a reminder, the Hebrew alphabets have corresponding numeric values. Thus, the numbers have indexes. Part and parcel of the Hebrew alphabet, the Bible defines numbers in contextual patterns for effective communication regardless of the historical period.

At hand, the number seven means an ending or a conclusion, like in the creation story where Elohim rested on the seventh day. Eight means newness, separation, renewal, hope, and a bright future—God, strength, and a strong leader. Thus, the eighth day represents a new week or the beginning of a process. Consider Noah and his eight family members were the seeds for starting a new planetary life.
