

Companion Chapters to July 31, 2023 Calendar Updates.

Numbers Chapters 23, 24, and 25
Isaiah Chapters 42, 43, and 44

An Indicant arrived from the Second Heaven on August 1 in the expository to Isaiah chapters 42, 43, and 44. The Court sent the expository to complement its Calendar Updates on July 31, 2023.

Again, an Indicant arrived from the Second Heaven on August 3 in expository to Numbers chapters 23, 24, and 25

The Judahite urges all to read the three chapters because they are supplementary to the Magistrate's Calendar Dates.

Still, The Judahite highlights verses herein for pathway studying.

Instructionally, the Congregation should use the Magistrate's July 31, 2023, Calendar Dates in companionship with the chapters and keep in view your relationship with occurring Calendar Dates.

An Outline

For some, the calendar dates are challenging to digest. While true, using the outline that follows with the Dates and Chapters will assist in the mental walk of understanding.

- I. Numbers 23:19. God is not a man that he should lie, neither the son of man that he should repent; therefore, what he said will be realized, and the things spoken will materialize.
- II. A new mindset must be fashioned, breaking down the old and creating a unique worldview wherein religious support systems will be a daily reality.
- III. Per Abrahamic Covenant and Jeremiah's Seventy-Years prophecy, we must prepare for the transitional stages as relocating and returning to the Lands of Promise in which we start exercising the freedom of labor to construct the Commonwealth of Israel. Translation: the Gentiles will **never again** feed off Judah and the Ten Tribes.

The Commonwealth of Israel is Yeshua's theocratic form of governance. By keeping the three themes in focus, one should always have confidence in walking in the right direction when monetarily falling behind in the tempo's Calendar Dates movement.

When combining Isaiah's chapters with the Calendar Dates, we gain descriptive explanations of TIME: the congregational history of the past, present, and future as directed by Elohim.
