UPDATE MAY 7 MEMORIAL MEAL

Approaching May 7, 2022, in the weeks of Pentecost or Shavuot, around 1:39 A.M. on May 6, The Judahite's pantry shelf collapsed supernaturally. The can goods fell to the floor along with many inventory goods. The glass vinegar bottle and the ceramic serving dish shattered. Noteworthy, around the vinegar bottle's neck, the spirit signals a notation.

In context, an accurate interpretation is rendered. In a similar miraculous act, the upper cabinet's shelf, holding a canister of coffee, miraculously repaired itself in a split second on Yeshua's birthday. Months prior, two of the shelf brackets had broken, though having a box of Green Tea to support the shelf.

The neck of the vinegar bottle captures the interpretative meaning. Two-thirds of the bottle remained intact, while the bottom of the jar was preserved as if cut with a glass cutter.

Vinegar is the symbolism of longevity—a perfect illustration of not being uprooted again. Detaching the glass bottom, yet preserving its form, signifies planting in a different place. The bottle cap remained tightly closed—the promise of preservation.

May 7 Memorial Meal

In the afternoon on May 6, The Judahite received illustrative instructions to prepare a meal. Having seen Jeremiah 24:6's programmatic thrust regarding collapsing shelf at 1:39 am, the meal would be a memorial meal to Yeshua's Mission Statement, which details in specificity to free the captative and give life abundantly. Therefore, the underline logic is the Congregation's relocation to PLANT anew.

The Memorial Meal comes as a milestone in the Feast of Weeks. The overall designed activities for the week appeared in the exercise of picking up and rearranging positive items for the body's health and relaxation. Still, the seventh day maintains its religious importance for people not to take for granted the sacred meaning of life as the expression of wholesomeness to our creator. The Congregation will once again PLANT the seeds of happiness and creativity in the Lands of Promise. Christ did not give a sacrifice unto himself; hence, the rejection of vinegar. When first offered vinegar, Christ smelled the vinegar and later rejected the second offer to drink the vinegar.

The Memorial Meal will be observed annually as the time to PLANT anew. Yeshua accepted the Man-child's libation honorarium.
