Many times it can portray a place, an activity, an action, a mood, a time, or name of a subject. It brings the viewer into the action and understanding of what is transpiring in what

they are looking at. Many old masters put titles of the place of the painting or who the person is. Some put the name of the action taking place, such as a celebration, or a war, or other event. Many have tried to portray Bible events or astrology figures with names included. How about a grumpy cat with fireworks and a humorous title?
