SCAMMERS AND FRAUD Gloria Writes.....

On a more serious note I have been getting garbage e-mails from sources about "my order or package has been sent, price quoted, etc. I never ordered anything? You want to answer and say "NO not my order, BUT... DO NOT ANSWER THEM, . ALWAYS LOOK AT THE RETURN ADDRESSES, AND THEN DELETE. ." Also I get hacked short messages from Cindy or others I DO know saying something about a photo or other subject ?? DO NOT OPEN. We identify our selves and write a subject concerning TEAM. We also get the PHOTO messages on "messenger." That false return address lets you know it is from a scammer, and if you answer, they have confirmation of your address and can look up other information and corrupt or charge to your account. Some scammers have put a lock on accounts and demand ransom to release again. This is BIG trouble for businesses. Some have put up thousands to get release as all their accounts and funds that are tied up and business closed down.

ONE SOLUTION . On TV news it showed a lady with floral business was shut down. The TV lawyer went to the SERVER of her web site. He said when you pay like "rent" for the space for your site, it is like renting a room. They have control over the space, The Server cut off the hacker and put the lady back in business again. Good to know.
