

Sending Postcards with the Interurban Railway Museum

Postcards are a great way to keep in touch with your favorite people. Even a small message can mean a lot! With one sheet of **cardstock**, a writing tool, and a stamp, you can get your special message anywhere! You can print your very own <u>Interurban Railway Museum Postcard</u> to get started.

Instructions:

- 1. Print your postcard! **Use cardstock.** It will protect your message from tears. You can also use other **thick paper**, or even **recycle greeting cards**! If those aren't available, see our <u>letter blog</u> for a link on how to make envelopes, and instructions on how to address one.
- 2. Flip the postcard over, it should be blank
- 3. Draw a line just right of center on the blank side
- 4. Write your address in the top left corner (optional)
- 5. Write your message anywhere on the left side of the line
- 6. Write your recipient's address on the right side of the line. Make sure there's some space for a stamp
- 7. Put a stamp in the top right corner
- 8. Your postcard is ready for the mail!
