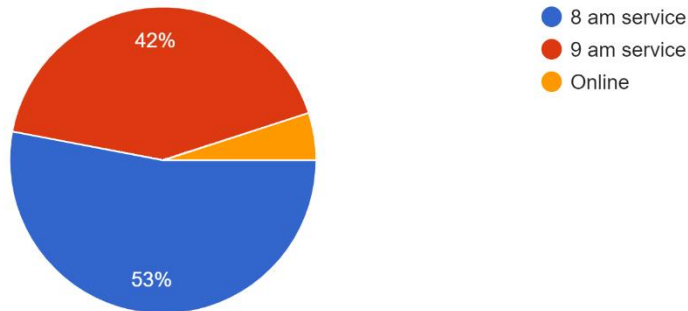
## Worship Survey Summary

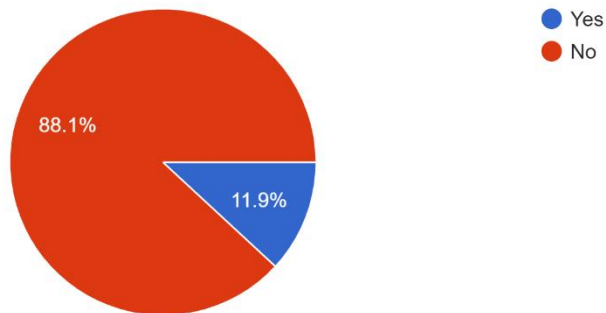

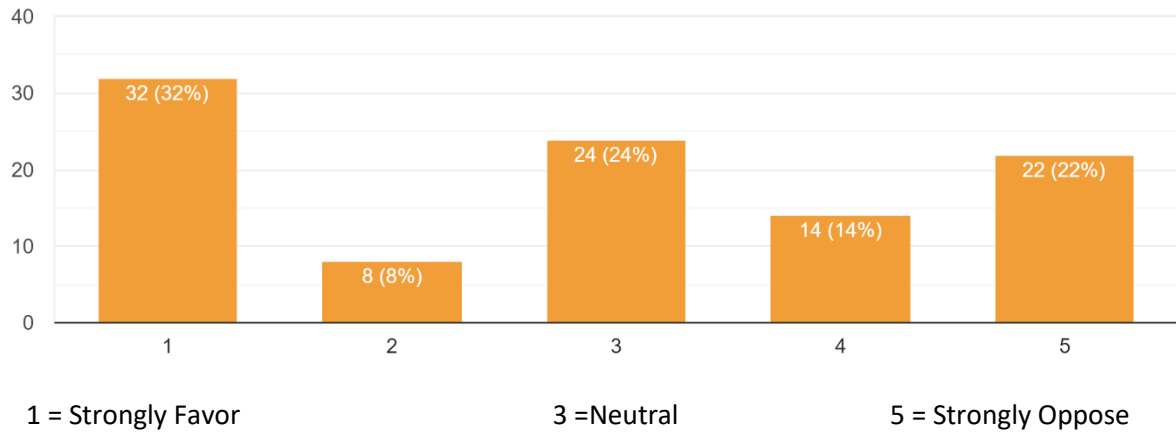
I am the parent/guardian of a Sunday School aged student

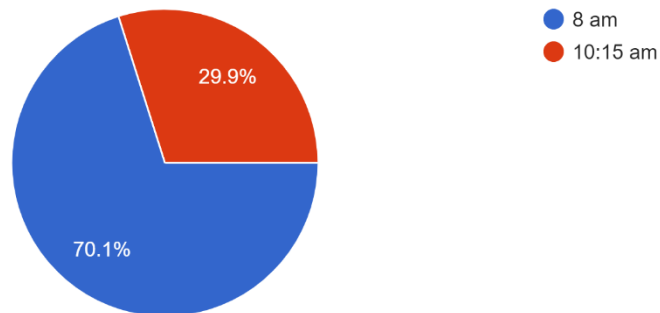
I prefer scheduling Sunday School at 9 am in-between the 8 AM service and the proposed 10:15 am service.

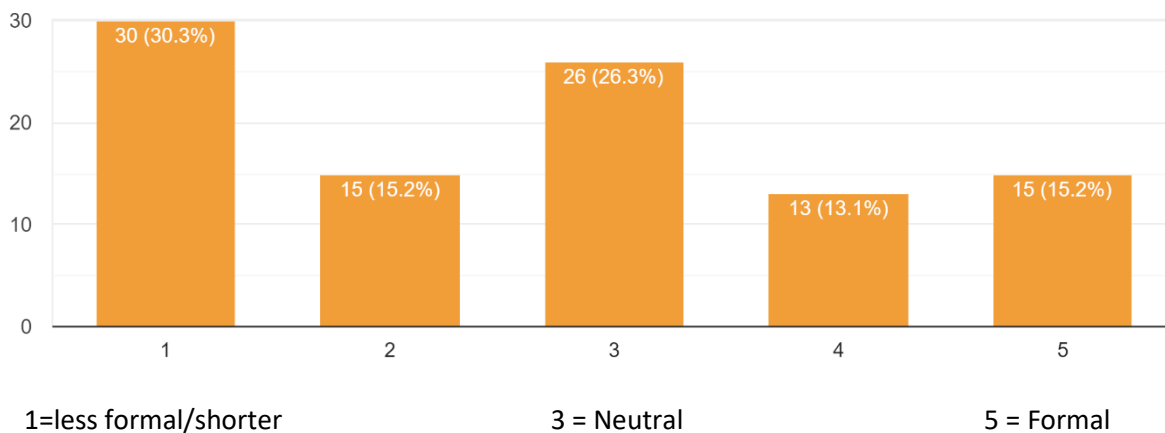
If Sunday School is moved to between the services, the worship service I would most likely attend is:

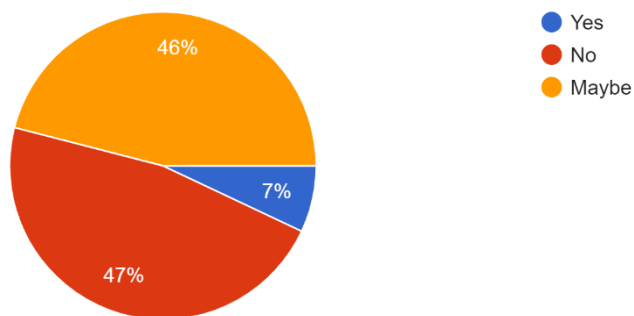

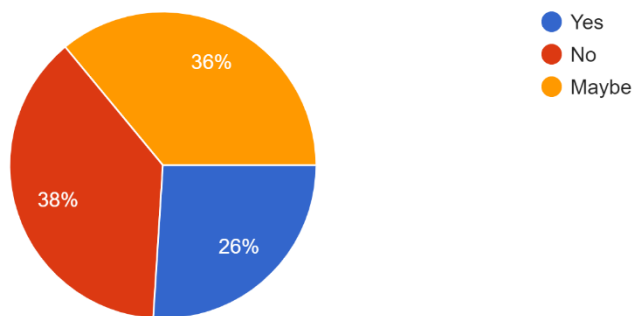
### Healing service with anointing (separate or part of Sunday morning worship)

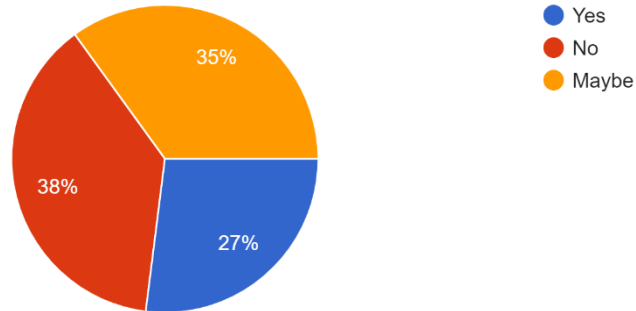

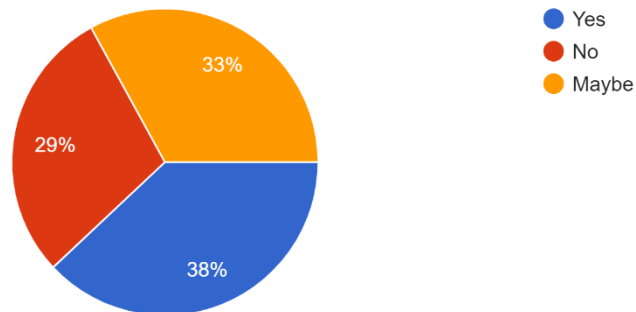

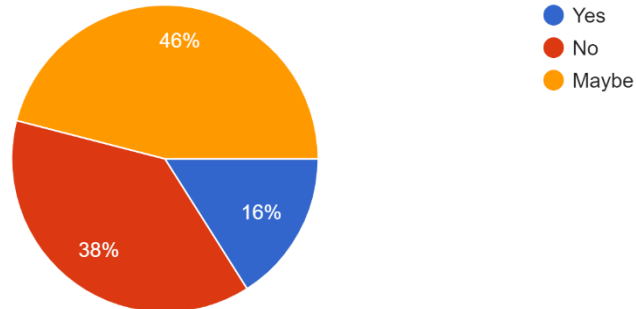
Recognition of Retirement and Redirection of Vocation (honoring retirees briefly during Sunday worship)

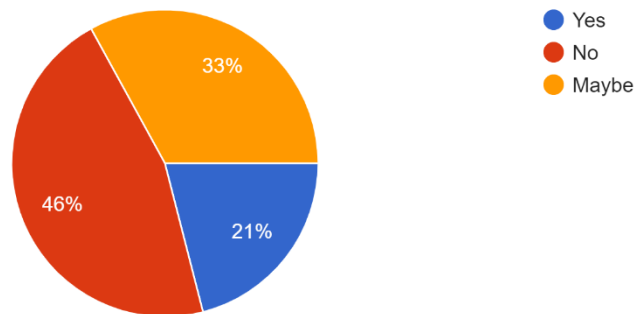
Evening Prayer (hymnal p. 309 - a solemn weeknight service with scripture, prayer, and sometimes song)

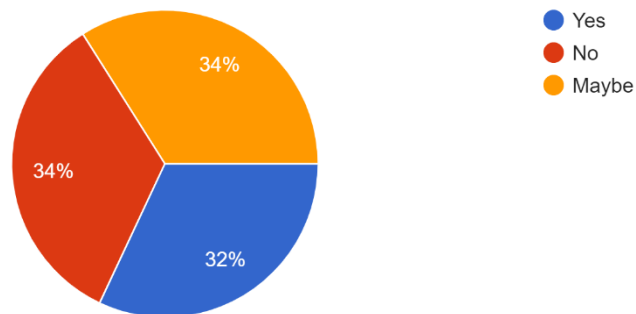
Pub/Coffee Shop ministry (meet at local pub/restaurant for Bible study, discussion, fellowship)
