### *From Pastor Scott*

Welcome to Lent  
We enter the season of Lent with Ash Wednesday on March 2, Lent is a season of reflection and preparation before the celebrations of Easter. By observing the 40 days of Lent, Christians replicate Jesus Christ's sacrifice and withdrawal into the desert for 40 days of preparation for his public ministry.

It's hard to avoid the subject of fasting when Lent comes around every year. I used to work with a guy who fasted from swearing during Lent; he struggled to finish his sentences (obviously, he had a swearing problem!). I never thought to ask him if he swears in Church on Easter morning!

Anyway, people ask me if they should give up Facebook or chocolate or eating meat on Fridays? As with all parts of Christian living, it depends on the motivation of your heart. You *should not* give up something if your motiva-

tion is to suffer a little bit with Jesus or to follow the rules.

For the Christian, Lent is ultimately about fasting from sin. It is an avoidance of anything that could interfere with, distract from, or disturb the preparation for the new Christian life with the risen Christ. The temporary interruption of some selfish habit for a limited time, with the intention of resuming the old habit after Easter, does not accomplish the Christian's goal. Lenten observances should aim for a permanent improvement of the Christian life. Consequently, you *may* give up something if your motivation is to grow in your faith.

One thing we might all want to consider giving up during Lent—and all year long, for that matter, is unloving, divisive speech and thinking. If we fasted from nastiness, just think about the healing

that could occur in Christ's name.

Another thing to consider is doing something extra. For instance, I invite you to support the Pick Six Lenten offering program (details inside). Try giving an additional weekly offering in addition to your regular giving to support ministries that help others.

You might also wish to consider redirecting your energies from yourself to others by volunteering in a new way on the various committees here at Swamp.

Of course, Lent is a perfect time to read the Bible and pray more often as we praise and worship the Lord. Take advantage of the midweek Lenten worship opportunities on Wednesday evenings (see schedule inside).

In this season of Lent, a time of repentance (changing direction) and self-examination, might we all redirect our minds and efforts to enhance our relationship with the Lord.

Never forget that God loves you and so do I,

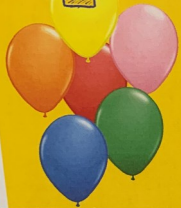
