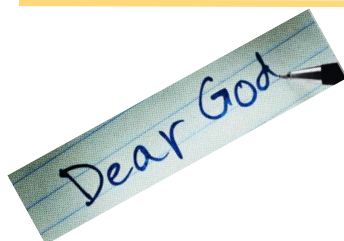
Please take note of the many activities to be held at Swamp in May. Our life in Christ at

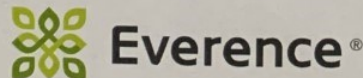
