
## **Outreach Update**



I wanted to share some of the data collected around EASS's food bank at Swamp Lutheran Church. I encourage you to share the information with your congregation and volunteers. Sometimes we can lose perspective month to month on the impact that is happening but when you look over a years' time, it is AMAZING what is happening.

From July 2022-June 2023 (This is PA Government Fiscal Year) 163,485 pounds of food was distributed 136,238 meals provided 4,431 individuals served (includes duplicates from month to month) 37 pounds of food on average is distributed each month to families from Swamp Food Bank.


